

Little Miami Schools is now using Schoology, an integrated learning management system that provides course management, mobile learning, and classroom communication. Schoology enables our students, parents and teachers to engage with learning materials and their school community from the classroom and beyond.

With Schoology, students can digitally view their calendars, submit homework assignments, participate in interactive discussions, receive announcements and feedback, and take assessments. Parents are able to view their child's activity, calendar and assignments.

New to Schoology? Parents will receive a parent access code and directions on how to login and create their Schoology account.

Had an account last year? Select login from www.Schoology.com and enter account info. If you cannot remember your password, click "Forgot Your Password" link and enter the email address registered with Schoology

Communication Highlights:


- The **Parent Email Digest** will have choices between daily and weekly for when you get notifications.

- The **Parent Email Digest** that you will receive will have: The child's current grading period grade for each course, A summary of marked attendance (late, absent, excused).

- Your child's teacher may supply you with a **group code** to join a **Parent Schoology Group**. This will also send **Push Notifications** for more communication from the classroom.

Setting up Email Notifications:

- 1) Log in to **Schoology Account**. (schoolology.com)
- 2) Click your name on the top right corner.
- 3) Click on **Settings**.
- 4) Click on your student's name.
 ** You will need to do the rest of the steps for each child.**
- 5) Click **Notifications Tab**.
- 6) Make your notification choices.

*** Make sure you are clicked on **your name** not your student's name! (This can be done in the top right hand corner.) ***

To access the Group after you have joined:

- 1) Click **Groups** at the top of page.
- 2) Click on the **Group Tile** that shows up.
- 3) Once in the group, Click on **Notifications** on the top right.
- Check the ways that you would like to be notified from the group.
Recommended to check the first option.

** Your child's teacher may be creating a group to allow more communication from the classroom.**

Things to consider:

- Download the **Schoology App** on your phone.
- When **checking grades**:
 - Make sure that you are on the right student.
 - View the **Grade Report**
 - Can view Overall Grade or view Each Assignment Grade.
 - Remember you can see the comments from the teacher but some assignments you won't be able to see the actual document from the Parent View.
 - The **Attendance Tab** will let you keep track of absent and sick days for each student.
